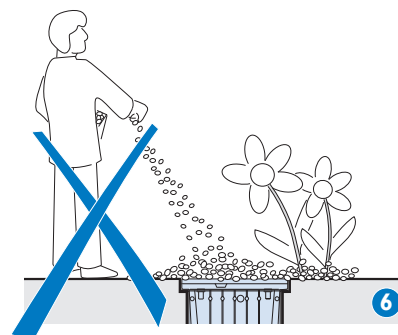
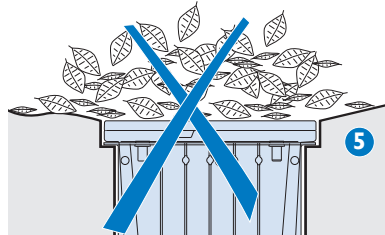
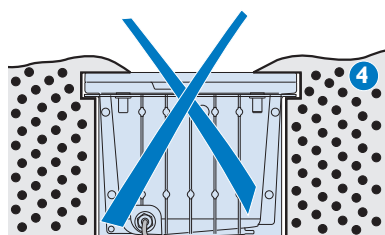
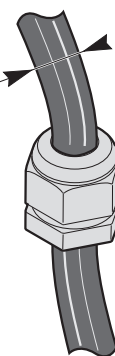


Prepare always 20 - 30 cm of drainage gravel and check that it works: fill the tube of water and check that it completely disappears within 30 min. If it doesn't work study a further drainage system (2).



Never install the fittings in case of rain, fog or high humidity.

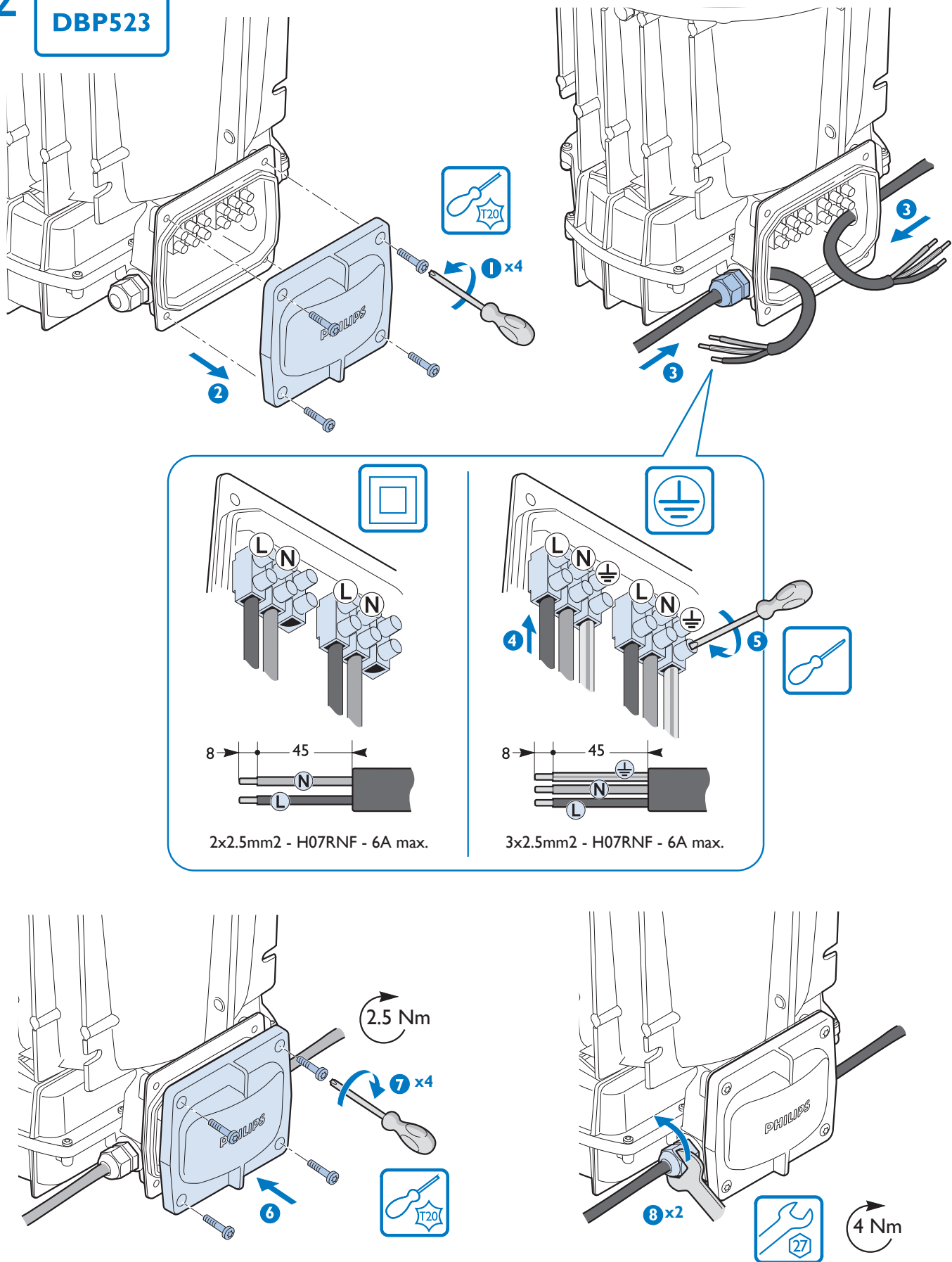
Use only allowed cable diameters.



Never cover visible parts of the fitting. Any part not protected by the recessing box, must not be in direct contact with the ground or in contact with aggressive chemical elements (ex. fertilisers, herbicides, lime (6)).

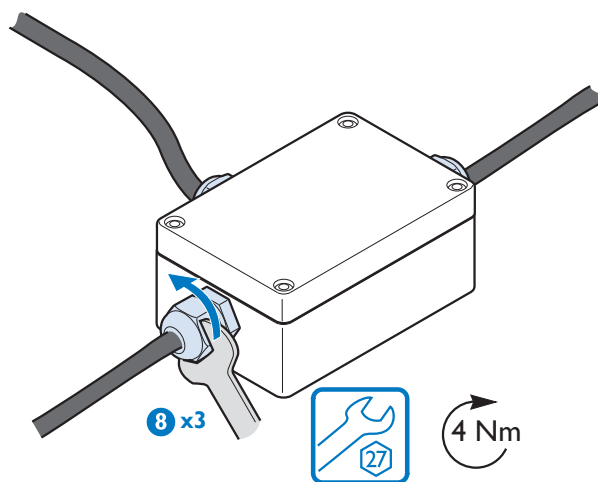
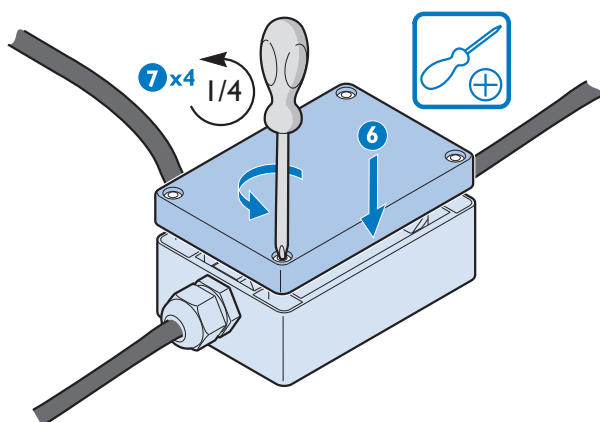
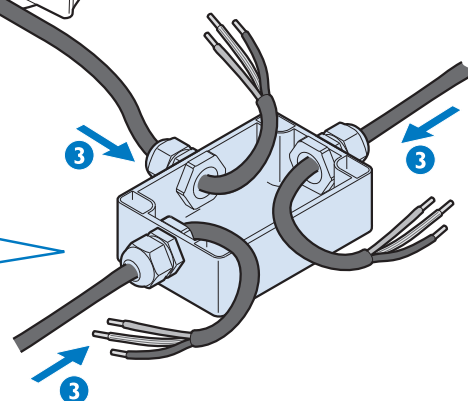
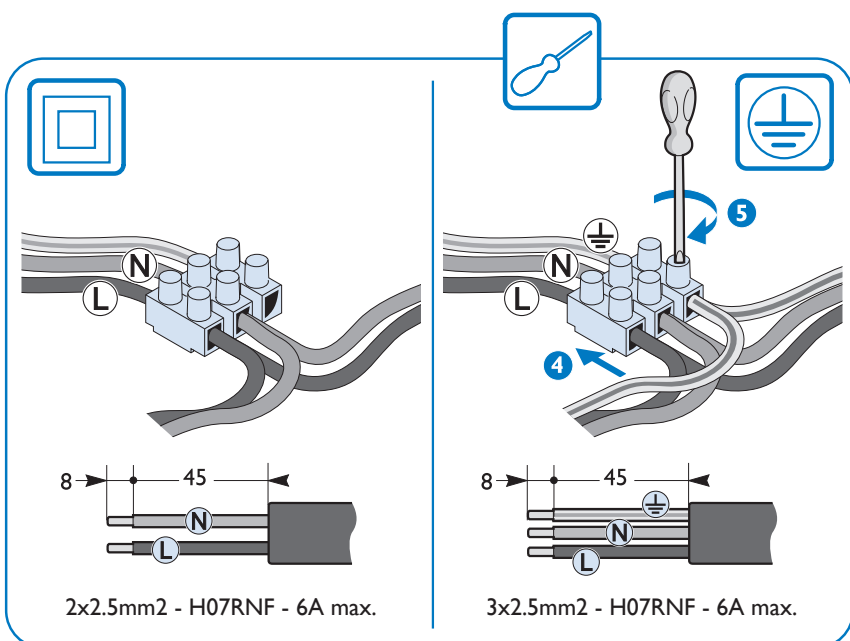
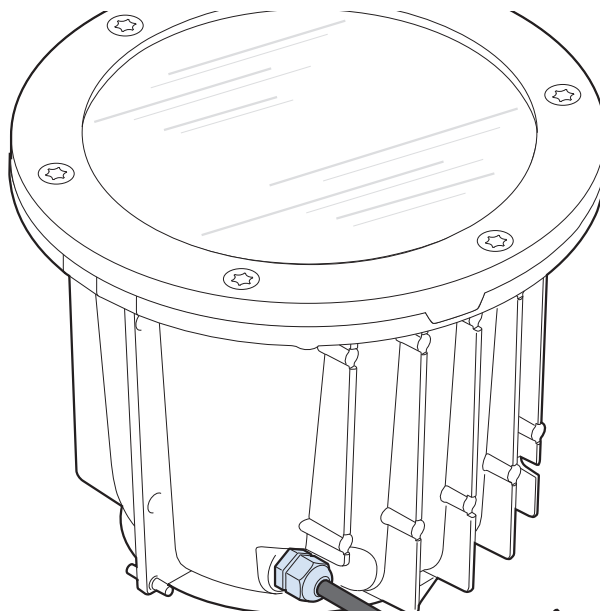
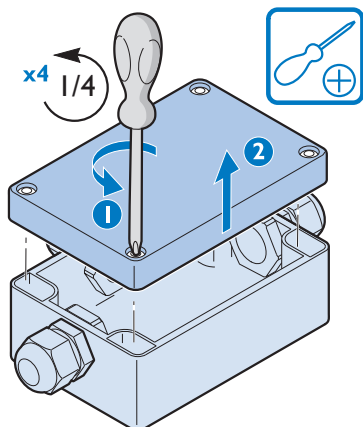

NOTE: Care should be taken regarding the compatibility between particular environments and luminaire construction, e.g. for the presence of de-icing agents, salt atmosphere, etc.

From 0 to 75 mm, the top side protruding over the ground should have a slope of $\alpha_{\max} = 35^\circ$, with vertex at 3 mm out of the edge (for a suitable chamfering). (c) Minimum value, see 13.6.1. (d) Up to 5 mm in these areas and up to 25 mm when installed in no-walking places, e.g., close to walls, buildings, etc.
