 To assure full compliance with local codes and regulations, check with your local electrical inspector before installation. To prevent electric shock, turn off electricity at fuse box before proceeding.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE CALCULITE COMPACT FLUORESCENT REFLECTOR TRIMS - CROSS BLADE SERIES

CAUTION: (RISK OF FIRE) DO NOT INSTALL INSULATION WITHIN 3 INCHES (76mm) OF FIXTURE SIDES OR WIRING COMPARTMENT, NOR ABOVE FIXTURE IN SUCH A MANNER SO AS TO ENTRAP HEAT.

1. REMOVE TRIM (Fig. A)

Remove CROSS BLADE TRIM from REFLECTOR HOUSING, pull CROSS BLADE TRIM down.

2. SNAP-IN (Fig. B)

Align TABS on SOCKET CUP with openings in REFLECTOR HOUSING and push in SOCKET CUP until RETAINING SPRING snaps in.

3. PUSH-UP REFLECTOR HOUSING (Fig. C)

Tilt REFLECTOR HOUSING and insert SOCKET CUP into ceiling opening on side opposite JUNCTION BOX. Pivot REFLECTOR HOUSING and push it up into ceiling.
 Note: To remove REFLECTOR HOUSING, disengage the SOCKET CUP by depressing the RETAINING SPRING. (Fig. B). Turn REFLECTOR HOUSING counterclockwise while pulling downward. After starting, use both hands to remove. (Fig. D)

4. LAMPING (Fig. E)

Note: See SOCKET CUP for lamping information.
 TRIPLE TUBE

Tilt lamp base to engage, line up LAMP PINS with SOCKET. Bring lamp to horizontal position and push into SOCKET. (Fig. E). To relamp, carefully pull straight out of SOCKET with one finger placed on the top end of the lamp.

5. PUSH-UP TRIM (Fig. F)

CROSS BLADE TRIM

Align SLOT in CROSS BLADE TRIM with TAB on REFLECTOR HOUSING in CROSS BLADE TRIM straight up into REFLECTOR HOUSING until flush with ceiling.

CAUTION: USE ONLY REFLECTOR TRIMS PROVIDED BY LIGHTOLIER. USE OF OTHER MANUFACTURERS' REFLECTOR TRIMS MAY VOID THE UNDERWRITERS LABORATORIES LISTING AND COULD CONSTITUTE A FIRE HAZARD.
