

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS **MANUAL PLUGGABLE TIMER**

Using the timer is very easy and you only have to remember that moving the tabs towards the outside of the dial equals ON, moving the tabs towards the inside of the dial equals OFF. Each segment represents 15 min, and there are a total of 96 tabs representing 24 hours in a day. Before using the timer, it is best to push in all tabs around the timer dial. You may now pull each 15-min. segment towards the outside of the dial for the times that you want the timer to switch ON.

SETTING THE CURRENT TIME

Now that you have set the times that you want the timer to switch ON or OFF, you need to set the current time of day by turning the dial **CLOCKWISE** until the current time of day is set against the arrow-head.

TECHNICAL DATA:

Operating Voltage: 120 VAC, 60 Hz.

WARNING: This timer is cannot be used as a surge protector. It is not recommended for use with aquariums and should be properly plugged into a polarized receptacle.
